This is the first event of a series of 8 Winter evening Street Orienteering events MVOC are organising generally on the 3<sup>rd</sup> Thursday of each month from September to April.



Each event will be a 1 hour score event and a league table will be compiled from the results of each event as they proceed. The best 4 results from the 8 events will determine the final league positions.

**Registration/Start location:** Barley Mow Public House -12 Pikes Hill, Epsom, Surrey KT17 4EA  
Accessible from either Pikes Hill or Depot Road Car Park.

**Parking:** Nearest car park - Depot Road Car Park (£1.50 after 6:30pm)

**Public transport:**  Train - Epsom Rail (11 min walk)  Buses - E16, 293, 406, 467, 470, 489, 516

**Score Event:** "Score" just means that there is no set course. Your map will show a number of controls, but you don't have to visit them all. You get points for each control you do visit, and lose points if you take more than an hour. You write down the answer to a simple question to show you have visited the control.

**Equipment required:** Watch; pen; torch or head torch; SI dibber for timed start and finish (these can be loaned on the day)

**Entry Fee:** Free to Moles, £2 to other BOF members, £3 to others.
