Enjoy navigating around the oldest cricket ground in the world, the site of the first ever women's road race in the world & korfbal match in the UK, the historic start of the London to Brighton ultra-marathon and the country's oldest fair in the historic landscape of Mitcham Cricket Green Conservation Area

Registration: Park Place (upstairs in the Toby Carvery) from 18.00. Entrance off Commonside West at grid reference TQ281684. Mitcham Junction rail/tram stop 900m. Mitcham tram stop 800m. Mitcham Eastfields (train) 1km. Additional parking off Madeira Road

Entry: Entry on the day only. Seniors £3, MV/SLOW/LOK/DFOK members & locals £2, under 21 free. SI electronic punching will be used and dibbers are available from registration

Map: Surveyed and drawn by Tony Burton 2013. Updated 2016. Maps will be overprinted and waterproof

Courses: Short: 2km (no road crossings)
Long: 5km (take care on road crossings)

Starts: 18.30 – 19.30. Outside Park Place. Courses close at 20.15

Terrain: Mix of grass & tarmac. Trainers & shorts can be worn. Spikes cannot
