NORBURY PARK NIGHT SCORE (part of the Kent Night Cup series)

Thursday 26th January 2017

Mole Valley Orienteering Club welcomes you to an evening score event at Norbury Park (as used for the recent South East Night Championships)

Directions: Car parking/Registration will be at the Young Street car park on the A246, close to the River Mole at GR TQ162551 (nearest postcode KT22 9BS). From M25 junction 9 (Leatherhead), follow "A24 Dorking" to Givons Grove Roundabout, then take "A246 Guildford" and the car park is 500m on the left. Approach from Givons Grove Roundabout only, right turns into the car park are prohibited. Nearest rail station is Leatherhead approx. 2km to the north. 465 bus from Kingston to Dorking passes car park and runs late enough for return journey. Nearest stop "Givons Roundabout".

Registration: on the night only 18:45-19:15 (please don't be late). Bring your SI dibber to Registration if you have one. Seniors £4, Juniors £1, SI dibber hire £1.

Please email [ditchi56-bof <at> yahoo.co.uk](mailto:ditchi56-bof@yahoo.co.uk) so that we can estimate map numbers. Four volunteer control collectors also required (to pick up 5 controls each).

Map: LIDAR based and remapped 2015 by Philip Gristwood. 1:10,000 printed on A4 size waterproof paper. No legend on the map. Control descriptions will be on the map only.

Terrain: Mostly deciduous woodland on chalk. Some very runnable. Flinty paths. Some steep slopes, slippery if wet.

Courses: this is a 60 minute score event, which means you decide which controls to visit during your hour. You may visit controls in any order. You get one point for each control found, and lose one point per minute (or part minute) if you are late back.

Starts: Mass start at 7:30pm.

Safety: Torch, backup torch and whistle compulsory, also possibly cagoules in inclement weather. Nearest A&E is Epsom Hospital, Dorking Road, Epsom, Surrey, KT18 7EG 01372 735 735
