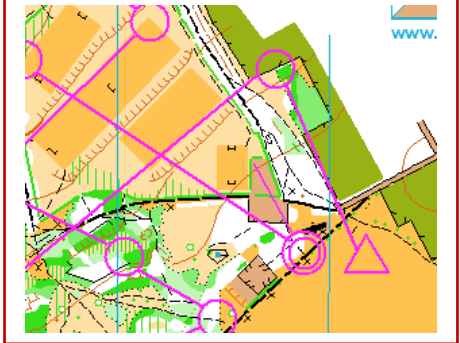

NO PREVIOUS EXPERIENCE OR EQUIPMENT NEEDED

Parking: The Priory School, Dorking, Surrey. OS Map 187, at Grid Ref TQ158488. Follow the 'Hill Race' signs from South end of Dorking one-way system.

Event centre: The Priory School. Toilets in the School. Dogs welcome.

Entry / Registration: In Priory School. 10.30am - 12.00pm. Entry on the day only.

Fees: Seniors £5.00. Juniors £2.00

Map: 1:5000, 5m contours, surveyed Jan 2015 using LIDAR data - maps will be overprinted on waterproof material

Courses: Still to be finalised. An easy course probably of about 2 Km; and a technically (and physically) harder one probably of about 3.5 Km.

The event will be using SportIdent electronic punching. (Hire charge £1)

Starts: 11.00am - 12.30pm. Courses close 2.30pm

Event Officials: Organiser/Planner – Graham Sutton (MV). In charge on the day – Deborah Sullivan (MV).

Whistles recommended. All competitors must report to download.
