Priory Park, Reigate Sunday 11th July 2021

Greater London Orienteering Summer Series (GLOSS)

The usual GLOSS courses of 4k with an optional extension of 2k, plus a yellow course of 2k will be offered

The event will be run in accordance with current British Orienteering (BO) & Government advice with regard to COVID-19

Entry System: All entries will be via <u>racesignup.co.uk</u>. Entries close at 18:00, 10th July. There will be no entries on the day

Entry Fees: £6 to all senior members, £2 to all juniors (under 16). Dibber hire £1. Helpers free.

Starts from 10.00 to 12.00. Course closes at 2.00

Priory Park has been newly mapped by Philip Gristwood. It comprises two adjoining areas. One is open grassland widely used by members of the public for general recreation and organised games. The other is a wooded area on the Greensand Ridge which comprises some challenging and open woodland together with some steep gradients. Map scale is 1:5000 with 5m contours using LiDAR data.

The Event Centre and the Start and Finish are in the eastern part of the open grassland near the entrance to Priory Park. Grid Ref TQ254500, nearest postcode RH2 7AQ, what3words marble.zealous.coats

Getting to the venue: Reigate is just south of junction 8 on the M25. It is served by trains from Victoria and London Bridge and also Guildford and Tonbridge. It is just a short (approx. ½ mile) walk south of the station.

Parking: There are several town car parks available nearby. The nearest, which adjoins Priory Park, is Bell Street postcode RH2 7AQ but this can fill up early. There is also a Morrisons car park very close by for use by customers with a two hour time limit. Bancroft Road, RH2 7RP (easiest from the East) and Nutley Lane RH2 9HS (easiest from the West) are both within easy walking distance. The cost on Sunday is £2.00 for 4 hours.

Safety: Nearest A&E is 3 miles away at East Surrey Hospital, Canada Avenue, Redhill RH1 5RH 01737 768511.

If lost in the wooded area bear north which will take you onto the open grassland. Full leg cover is mandatory The grass area is widely used by members of the public and can be quite crowded on a Sunday so please respect other users. There will also be plenty of walkers in the wooded area.

Dogs: Welcome if kept under control
