Reigate Urban **Sunday 27th August 2023**

The UK Urban League and Southern England Orienteering Urban League (SEOUL) come to historic and medieval market town of Reigate. Sitting below the North Downs escarpment, courses will visit Reigate Priory and Castle.

Entry: [Racesignup.co.uk](https://www.racesignup.co.uk). Seniors £10, Juniors (u21) / students £4 by 20 August. Seniors £12, Juniors £6 by 25 August and entry on day (subject to map availability, payment by card only). £2 surcharge for non-BOF Seniors. SI-Card hire £1 (lost units £30) or contactless SIAC hire £2.50 (lost units £65).

Event centre: **To be confirmed.** (*Hoping to be able to use Reigate Priory Cricket Club, [Park Lane, Reigate RH2 8XY](#) with space for parking for first ~60 cars, located ~5 minute walk to the start, with toilets, water (tap), registration and download. Remaining vehicles to use town car parks. Reigate railway station 10-15 min walk.*)

Map: New 1:4,000 map by Mike Elliot surveyed 2023, overprinted and waterproof. Expecting A3 double sided for longer courses, A3 single sided for mid length courses and A4 single sided for courses 6 and 7.

Courses: (Contactless SI electronic punching will used), provisional lengths subject to final controlling. These are straight line lengths, expect to run ~30-40% further.

- 1 8.5km Men's Open
- 2 7.4km Women's Open, Men's Veterans (40+)
- 3 6.2km Women's Veterans (40+), Men's Super Veterans (55+)
- 4 4.6km Women's Super Veterans (55+), Men's Ultra Veterans (65+)
- 5 3.6km Women's Ultra Veterans (65+), Women's/Men's Hyper Vets (75+)
- 6 2.9km Men's Junior (16-), Women's Junior (16-)
- 7 2.0km Men's Young Junior (12-), Women's Young Junior (12-)

Courses 6 and 7 will be within Reigate Priory Park (no road crossings).

Starts: 10.30 to 12.30. Courses close 14.30. Start / Finish in [Reigate Priory Park](#).

Results: provisional live via QR code on splits printout and final on mvoc.org soon after the event.
